The Society of Women Engineers Greatland Section is pleased to offer one \$2,000 and two \$1,500 scholarships to female high school seniors in Alaska planning to pursue a degree in engineering. Please fill out the attached application and submit to the SWE Greatland Scholarship Committee by **Wednesday**, **February 7**, **2024**.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must be a young woman who:

- is a high school senior in Alaska
- intends to enroll in an ABET-accredited engineering program at a four-year college or university (engineering programs that are not ABET-accredited do not qualify). ABET accreditation provides assurance that a college or university program meets the quality standards of the profession for which that program prepares graduates. ABET-accreditation assures your entry to a technical profession through licensure, registration, and certification- all of which often require graduation from ABET- accredited program as a minimum qualification. Please note that many computer science programs are not ABET- accredited. Please be sure to verify with your college the ABET- accreditation for any programs you are intending to pursue.

- Academic Performance

- Engineering Fit
- Application Presentation

Please be aware of the following deadlines:

February 7, 2024	Required application materials listed above must be postmarked by this date.
April-May, 2024	Applicants will be notified of scholarship results. Scholarship recipients will receive a certificate at their senior awards ceremony.
