

#### Introduce a Girl to Engineering Day

The Society of Women Engineers – Houston Area held its annual Introduce a Girl to Engineering Day (IAGTED) February 18th, 2023. The goal of this event is to provide exposure to engineering concepts and activities for students in grades 6 through 9.

This year, almost 120 students participated in the day long event held on campus at the University of Houston. The event schedule featured a keynote speaker from The Chemours Company - Julie B. Johnson, who provided some inspiring words to the students on pursuing careers in STEM. Students participated in 3 different activities over the course of the day providing them an opportunity to learn about different engineering disciplines. This year's activities featured electrolysis, water filtration, and rubber band cars.

Students also had the opportunity to interact throughout the day with over 70 engineers who served as volunteers for the event asking questions about what it is like to be an engineer. The event was made possible by multiple corporate sponsors such as The Chemours Company, ChampionX, Quiddity, DiscoverE, and Time For Change, LLC..
