

Retaining Women in Engineering: Leveling the Playing Field

Hosted by Bob Stavig, co author of: Retaining Women in Engineering: The Empowerment of Lean Development.

At the current rate, it will take 350 years to achieve gender parity.

During this session, we will focus on 3 aspects of this challenge:

1) The Gender Schema (broader than stereotypes) that begins to form as early as 2 years old which shape our expectations and beliefs of girls and boys which eventually drives career and life choices.
